PUBLIC HEARING AND ACTION ITEM

The City Council will conduct a public hearing for the purpose of receiving public comment and testimony regarding a proposed annexation to enlarge and extend the boundary limits of the City of Niederwald, Texas, to include approximately 10.02 acres of land out of the Otis G. Eels Survey, Abstract No. A-167, located on Schubert Lane, Hays County, Texas, said tract being contiguous and adjacent to the existing city limits of the City of Niederwald, Texas; followed by discussion and possible action to adopt an ordinance regarding the annexation of the approximately 10.02 acres of land and associated matters.


