#### **ACTION ITEMS**

- Individuals wishing to speak on an Agenda item will be allowed to speak when the agenda item is called. Comments made during this time must be directly related to the agenda item under discussion and comments shall be limited to three (3) minutes per person.

6. Discussion and possible action on an ordinance approving a budget amendment due to unforeseen circumstances and for municipal purposes to create a Capital Improvements budget fund and reallocate dollars in the total amount of \$300,000.
7. Discussion on an ordinance amending the City of Niederwald Zoning Ordinance and Official Zoning Map to establish a citywide Mixed-Use zoning district and revise permitted and conditional uses, including adoption of conditional use permit procedures and standards.
8. Discussion and possible action on selecting and approving a quote for the City Hall Parking Lot Project and authorizing the City Secretary to proceed with execution and payment.
