ORDINANCE NO. 020500-B

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A SURVEY OF THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF NIEDERWALD; PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE AND REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES OR RESOLUTIONS.

WHEREAS, a Texas general-law municipality may adopt ordinances that are for the good of government, peace, or order of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, Section 41.002 of the Texas Local Government Code provides for the survey of the boundaries of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, Section 41.002 further provides that the survey must be based on the boundaries designated in the petition for incorporation;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Niederwald, Texas desires to adopt this ordinance in accordance with Section 41.002 of the Texas Local Government Code:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NIEDERWALD, TEXAS, THAT:

I.

The City shall, in compliance with the Professional Services Procurement Act, contract with a state licensed professional land surveyor, to perform a survey of the boundaries of the City of Niederwald, Texas. The City shall select and award the contract to a land surveyor on the basis of demonstrated competence and qualifications for the type of services to be performed and at fair and reasonable prices. In accordance with the Professional Services Procurement Act, the land surveyor shall not be selected on the basis of competitive bidding.

II.

The survey must be based on the boundaries designated in the petition for incorporation of the City of Niederwald, Texas.

III.

Upon completion of the survey, the field notes of the survey must be recorded in the minutes of the City of Niederwald and in the deed records of the counties in which the City is located, that is Hays and Caldwell counties.

- A. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, or resolutions in conflict herewith are expressly repealed.
- B. The invalidity of any section or provisions of this ordinance shall not invalidate other sections or provisions thereof.
