

**DISASTER ORDINANCE NO: 10-28-98**

WHEREAS, on October 21, 1998, the Mayor issued a proclamation declaring a state of disaster for the City of Niederwald resulting from extreme amounts of rainfall, flood stage and above waters in local rivers and tributaries, leaving the ground and low lying areas saturated with flood and runoff waters;

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating declaration of a state of disaster continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, Section 418.108 of the Texas Disaster Act of 1975, as amended, Vernon's Texas Codes Annotated, Government Code Chapter 418, provides that local state of disaster may not be continued for a period in excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision;



Now, Therefore, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NIEDERWALD:

Section 1. That the state of disaster proclaimed for the City of Niederwald by the Mayor on October 21, 1998 shall continue until terminated by order of the City Council


